This is a civil rights action for damages and injunctive relief. Plaintiffs bring claims regarding the conditions of confinement and practices involved in the incarceration of Kathy Robbins and other juveniles in the Glenn County Jail, located in Willows, California.

The complaint in this matter was filed on May 14, 1985. The defendants duly answered and denied the material allegations of the complaint. The parties have stipulated that this matter may proceed, for the purposes of injunctive relief only, as a class action under Rule 23(b) of the Federal Rules of Civil Procedure.



1 The class consists of all juveniles who are or will be confined
2 in the Glenn County Jail.

3 While neither admitting nor denying any allegations of fact
4 or legal liability, the parties have now agreed to the entry of a
5 consent judgment. Therefore, based upon the agreement of all
6 parties to this action, by and through their respective counsel,
7 and based upon all matters of record in this case, it is hereby
8 ORDERED, ADJUDGED and DECREED that:

9 1. This court has jurisdiction over this matter.

10 2. The plaintiffs are LILLIAN ROBBINS, as administratrix of
11 the estate of Kathy Robbins, who died in the Glenn County Jail on
12 August 29, 1984; LILLIAN ROBBINS and JAMES ROBBINS, SR., as
13 surviving parents and heirs of Kathy Robbins; and TIMOTHY S., by
14 and through GLORIA S., his mother, on behalf of himself and all
15 other juveniles similarly situated.

16 3. The defendants in this action are COUNTY OF GLENN,
17 CALIFORNIA and ROGER L. ROBERTS, Sheriff of the County of Glenn,
18 California, in his official capacity. Former defendants C. B.
19 Harrison, Todd James, Virginia Collins, John Edwards, J. L.
20 Brandenberger, Diana Killebrew, Becky Bartucco, Virginia
21 Ingraham, Fran Langford, Peter R. Ramirez, Jane Hahn, George A.
22 Edwards, George F. Pride, Joe Williams, Keith C. Hansen, and
23 Roger L. Roberts, in his individual capacity, have been dismissed
24 from this action with prejudice, pursuant to a settlement
25 agreement with said defendants and the COUNTY OF GLENN pertaining
26 to damages only, under which plaintiffs LILLIAN ROBBINS and JAMES



1 ROBBINS, SR. will be paid the sum of one hundred twenty-five
2 thousand dollars (\$125,000.00) in consideration of a full and
3 final release from all of their claims in this matter. Said
4 settlement is a bar to any further award of damages herein.

5 4. This action is properly maintained as a class action for
6 purposes of injunctive relief only under Rule 23(b) of the
7 Federal Rules of Civil Procedure.

8 5. The plaintiff class consists of all juveniles who are or
9 will be confined in the Glenn County Jail.

10 6. As of August 1, 1986, the defendants COUNTY OF GLENN and
11 ROGER L. ROBERTS, in his official capacity as Sheriff of Glenn
12 County, will cease utilizing the Glenn County Jail for the
13 confinement of juveniles.

14 7. The plaintiffs reserve the right to request such
15 attorneys' fees and costs as this Court deems appropriate and
16 defendants reserve the right to oppose such requests.


17 8. The agreement set forth herein constitutes a fair and
18 reasonable resolution of plaintiffs' claims and is therefore
19 approved by this Court.






