The TAY Civil Legal Practice Exchange is a group of civil legal advocates across California that convenes regularly to share resources, exchange technical assistance, develop referral pathways, and identify recurring issues related to the civil legal needs of transition-age young people. The Practice Exchange provides monthly webinars for advocates on a variety of TAY-specific topics including housing, access to services, and transition-planning among many others. We also host a bi-monthly workshopping hour which offers a more interactive, collaborative space to brainstorm and problem-solve around recurring issues in TAY advocacy work across the state.
